RE: 2024 KSTD Septage & Leachate Adjustments

Dear Valued Hauler,

I am writing you today to inform you that the KSTD Board of Trustees has approved rate adjustments on all septage and leachate disposal rates as shown in Table 1 (below), <u>effective May 13, 2024</u>. As mentioned in 2023, our biosolids disposal rate continues to rise as PFAS legislation further limits available options for biosolid disposal in the State of Maine. The global 8.16% increase is reflective of the budgetary increase of the Administration & Operations/Maintenance portions of the District Budget from FY2023 to FY2024, respectively. This increase is necessary to keep up with the rising cost of wastewater treatment. Thank you in advance for your understanding.
